UseKilo: Software Engineer (2025- Present)

- Updated MantineUI from v6 to v7. Increasing reusability of the components and decreasing load time for whole web app by significant margin.
- wrote test for django models using pytest, reaching test coverage of 90% for big part of 40 models existing in project

Everai: intermediate Front - End engineer (2024 – 2025)

- Developed and enhanced a Ruby on Rails application that supports over 10,000 registered users, generating 1M+ in monthly revenue; utilized frameworks including StimulusJS and AlpineJS.
- Developed Landing Pages, that proved to increase user conversion rates by 5-10%.
- Developed promotional updates focused on user conversion rates. Did most of the UI updates on whole application
- Introduced new ways to write responsive and reusable frontend components, this effectively cut frontend related tasks complexity mostly by 1 point (using Story Points system)
- Managed app on heroku, including dynamic data for landing pages. Set up and managed Review Apps for github pull requests using heroku CLI.
- Demonstrated professional collaboration by initiating and efficiently planning activities such as pair programming sessions and introductory calls, fostering seamless communication and connection among remote team members worldwide.
- Explored new ways for testing app cross platform using BrowserStack, for reducing QA testing time and efficient feature deliverability.

Noxtton: Senior Front - End engineer (2021 - 2024)

- Developed an App that functioned as company's internal CMS, Hosting, easy authentication and statistics dashboard. As of Today app supports over 30 projects. In process managed and lead team with 5+ engineers, taking responsibility for sprint planning using Jira.
- Took initiative for updating back-end for CMS as well, creating new api-s, statistics calculating logic and multi-language support for stored information further reducing development time for other web applications
- Was single developer for creating flexible Intranet application that is used by one of the biggest company in my country with over 300 employees. Application is created with flexibility in mind, so it can be used by other companies.
- Was heavily invested in recruitment process, done interviews and checked test projects for new employees. Created new, more dynamic ways for onboarding new developers and introducing them to agile development, which proved useful, providing smooth transition on later individual projects.
- Was part of developing company wide template NextJs project, helper options already set up such as ReactQuery, Typescript, Our internal CMS apis-s, CMS data types generation script, ESLint. This proved useful giving developers ability to jump on the project right away without completing tedious setup.
